Scholarship Application ~ Due by May 15th, 2026 for high school applicants. **Please note our annual Spring Art Show will take place May 8th & May 9th (Drop Off May 7th).*

The Corry Artists' Guild gives away scholarships of varying amounts annually to:

- High school seniors entering college in the fall immediately following graduation and majoring in a field of visual arts. Public, private, cyber, charter, and home schooled students are eligible.
- Adults continuing their art education and to guild members for continuing art education classes (must be a current resident of Erie, Crawford, or Warren County).

How scholarships are awarded:

- Applications will be judged by CAG executive board members unrelated to the applicant.
- A scholarship check will be issued directly to the school bursar's office.

Requirements:

- Completed application
- Digital portfolio or flash drive containing clear images of at *least* 7 pieces of artwork must be submitted with application. Seven printed photos are also acceptable.

- One letter of recommendation from an adult not related to the applicant.
